First Reading	Qo 1:2; 2:21-23
Responsorial Psalm	Ps 89:3-6.12-14.17
Second Reading	Col 3:1-5.9-11
Gospel	Lk 12:13-21

18TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: Today's first reading opens with the verse from Ecclesiastes, "Vanity of vanities – all is vanity!" Vanity means something empty, of no real or lasting value. Jesus explains what this means with a parable. A man had such a good harvest that he decided to build bigger barns to store it but he was destined to die that night! The only treasure that really lasts is what counts in the eyes of God. St Paul tells us to seek the things that are of heaven because our real life is hidden with Christ and will be revealed only when we are with him for ever. Life here and now is not a mirage or dream but it is only the prelude to a much greater life. We must see what we do here and now in the light of what is to come.
