**14TH SUNDAY OF YEAR:** “Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest. Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.” Friday was the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and June a month dedicated in honour of the Sacred Heart – normally the Feast falls in June. It is a wonderful image. The depiction of the Sacred Heart shows the Heart of Jesus as a source of light and surrounded by the thorns of his Passion – the cost of his love. However, in the light of today’s Gospel we might want to think of the Last Supper where St John reclines alongside Jesus, his head resting next to Jesus’ Heart. There he found rest and inspiration. We too find rest, encouragement and inspiration when we turn to the Lord in an intimate way and allow ourselves to rest in his embrace. It is not a form of escapism! If we shoulder his yoke and learn from him then he will bear our burdens and take the weight from our shoulders.
