14TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: “The Lord appointed seventy two others and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit.” These words from today’s Gospel are wonderfully appropriate, for today we welcome the visiting team from the SION Community. During this week they will be going out in pairs with the aim to visit every known Catholic home in our parish. Their role is to prepare the way for the Lord not only by telling people about the ‘Celebration Week’ and its events, but also by sharing something of their Faith with each family, and giving you an opportunity to share your Faith or concerns with them in a moment of prayer. This opening of hearts to the Lord is not so much preparation for the second week but the heart of our parish outreach! Please do pray for them each day and make them welcome if you are in when they call. They will identify themselves by producing a poster advertising the Mission.

PARISH BEREAVEMENTS: We are sad to announce the deaths of two parishioners last Sunday. Joan Hare had been a stalwart at Tiptree for many years and was secretary at St John Payne School when it opened fifty years ago. She was also a great supporter of The Oasis Bookshop in Tiptree. She had been very frail for some time, but was fully conscious although on oxygen when she received the Sacraments for the last time on Saturday. Her funeral has been arranged for this Friday (9th July) 1.00 p.m. at Tiptree, followed by cremation at Colchester at 2.45 p.m. Frank Joyce of Coggeshall was not as well known to parishioners but was occasionally well enough for his family to bring him to Mass in a wheelchair, and attended one of our Curry Evenings. His body will be taken to Ireland for burial but arrangements have not yet been made.

PARISH MISSION: Visiting Week. During this first week Mass times will be as usual, except for Tuesday when Mass will be at 9.00 a.m. Before the end of Mass there will be a brief time of ‘faith sharing’ led by a team member.

MUSIC GROUP: The final rehearsal for those wishing to learn the music for the Parish Mission with our folk band was held last Thursday evening 1st July. For those who have found Thursday evenings inconvenient, there will be an opportunity at the Mission Workshop to be held here in the parish on Sunday 11th July.

THE BISHOP'S AUTUMN MANOEUVRES: These are minimal this year, no doubt in part because the Bishop will retire in June 2011 and does not want to limit the possibilities for his successor. Fr John Meehan is taking a year's sabbatical, and Fr David Clemens has resigned his parish for health reasons. Fr Paul Dynan is taking over the two parishes of Stanford-le-Hope and Tilbury, and will be succeeded as Parish priest of Basildon by Fr Dominic Howarth. Fr Brett Adams will be moving from Colchester to Basildon to assist him. Rev. Neill Brett will be appointed to Colchester on his ordination in September. Fr Mark Riley is confirmed as assistant priest at Forest Gate. Fr James Mackay, who has just completed his studies in Rome, will be appointed to Brentwood Cathedral.

VISUAL DISPLAY: We have been busy preparing display boards to represent the different themes of the Parish Mission. First of all thank you to *all* of you who have been involved in this work so far. For the theme of 'Healing and Reconciliation' we are asking parishioners to write down any 'Intentions' they have eg to pray for a sick relative or friend. There will be coloured card which will be left at the back of the church today for this purpose. Please either fill them out straight away and leave them at the back of church or feel free to take them home if you wish to write a special prayer, add a memento which can be pinned to the board etc. The end result we hope will be that we will fill a triptych display board so that we can pray together for all our intentions. Anyone who hasn't returned their nasturtiums can still do so by leaving them at the back of the church.

MISSION TWINNING: Over the past weeks we have been supported in prayer by parishioners from Our Lady Immaculate in Devizes, who will have their own Mission in October. In our turn we are asked to support them from now on with our prayer as they begin their final preparations. The parish is served by Father Philip Baptiste MSFS, Father Saji Mathew MSFS and Rev. MISSION PRAYER GROUP

The first week of our Mission is finally here. While the Mission Team are visiting our homes morning, afternoon and evening all week, the Prayer Group has arranged prayer times at Kelvedon to support the visits with much needed prayer. As you know the church is open all day for you to call in and pray, but we are arranging some structured sessions.

Each morning following refreshments after the morning Mass at Kelvedon (9.00 a.m. Monday, Tuesday and Friday and 10.00 a.m. Thursday) there will be an opportunity to revisit some of our favourite devotions - such as *Stations of the Cross* in different forms, *Rosary* and hopefully 15 minutes *Exposition before the Blessed Sacrament*.

Every afternoon from 2.30 p.m. for approximately an hour there will be a **'Bring and Share'** prayer time. Bring your own readings and prayers and share them with other parishioners.
