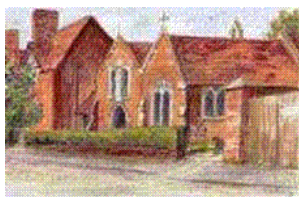

### **NINTH SUNDAY OF YEAR**

*The house built on rock and the house  
built on sand.*

**First Reading: Deut 11:18.26-28.32**

**Responsorial Psalm PS 30:2-4.17.25**

**Second Reading: Rom 3:21-25.28**

**Gospel: Mt 7:21-27**



**NINTH SUNDAY OF YEAR:** “God’s disciples need to have firmly anchored in their souls the remembrance of their Master, Jesus Christ, and to think of him day and night. They must learn where to begin, and how and where to construct the rooms in their buildings, and how to bring those buildings to completion. Otherwise all the passers-by will mock them, as our Lord said about the man who set out to build a tower and could not finish it. The foundation is already laid, as Saint Paul said: it is Jesus Christ our God. *If anyone builds on this foundation with gold or silver or precious stones, or with wood or straw or stubble, his work will be brought to light, because fire will reveal it and test the quality of each one’s work.* Good habits and righteousness in all their beauty are what Paul compared to gold, silver, and precious stones.” Philoxenus of Mabbug. Jesus tells us that if we listen to his words and act on them our house will be founded on rock. Our habits reflect our underlying values precisely because we practise them without consciously thinking about them. Do our habits as well more conscious choices point to a solid foundation on Christ’s word?

**LENT:** This Wednesday is **Ash Wednesday** and marks the beginning of Lent. It is a time when we join spiritually with those preparing for baptism or reception into full communion this Easter by fasting, prayer and almsgiving. This year we pray for several people in the parish who will be joining the Church at Easter and also for all those up and down the country who will be entering the new Ordinariate for former Anglicans. **Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence** from meat for those aged fourteen and upwards and of fasting (one meal and two snacks) for those aged 18-60. It is not a holy day of obligation but Mass will be at the usual Holy Day times: 10.00 a.m. Kelvedon; 6.00 p.m. Coggeshall; 7.30 p.m. Tiptree. To help your Lenten preparations for Easter the usual booklets are available: ‘*Walk with me*’ & ‘*My Day by Day*’ cost £1.00; the Junior & Infant ‘*My Day by Day*’ cost £0.50.
