

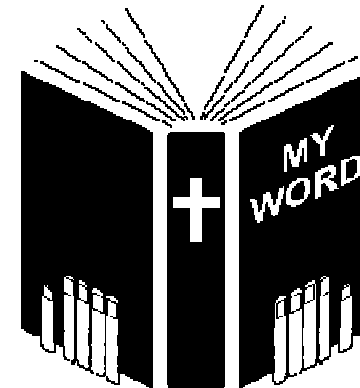

The Holy Spirit will remind you of all I have said to you

First Reading	Acts 15:1-2.22-29

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: In today's Gospel Our Lord tells the disciples that he will soon leave them, but will send the Holy Spirit as an Advocate who will teach them and remind them of everything he has taught them. In today's first reading from Acts of the Apostles we are shown an important example of the Spirit in action. Disagreement arose over how pagans should be welcomed into the Church. Should they be required first to convert to Judaism and to accept the requirements of the Jewish Law? The Apostles decided to meet at Jerusalem to look into the matter and reach a decision. This they did and it is regarded as the first Church Council. The Holy Spirit works not just through direct inspiration but also the ordinary human means whereby people discuss a problem and conscientiously strive to reach a solution. This applies when the successors of the Apostles in union with the successor of Peter meet to reflect on the needs of the Church or decide disputes questions. Since that time there have been twenty 'Ecumenical' (i.e. whole Church rather than local) Councils, most recently Vatican II 1962-1965.
