15th Sunday of Year *Who is my neighbour?*

First Reading	Dr 30:10-14
Responsorial Psalm	Ps 68:14.17.30-31.33-34.36-37

15TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: “Master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbour as yourself.” To illustrate this Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan. To his Jewish audience a Samaritan would not be a role model, but an outsider, yet he is the one who proves himself a neighbour by his compassion and generosity. He may not conform to the Jewish Law or hold orthodox beliefs, but God sees the love in his heart.
