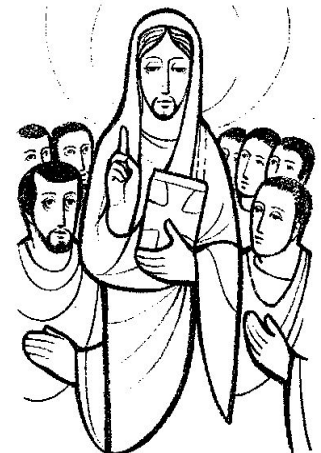
*You have learnt how it was said to your

Gospel: Mt 5:17-37



SIXTH SUNDAY OF YEAR: "As we continue our reflection on Matthew's great sermon, we hear a long Gospel passage today that may seem to be complex and filled with prohibitions (5:17-37). It is far too easy to "tune out" such a Gospel text, rather than trying to understand its rich meaning. The passage (5:17) begins with a word of reassurance: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill." The law remains and will always remain because it comes from our unchanging God. Jesus intends to state the ideals of the new kingdom on earth that is ushered in by his appearance. His whole intention is to bring people beyond legalism -- which seriously affected the Scribes and the Pharisees -- and a literal interpretation of rules, and into the spirit of the law. Jesus teaches that minimal obedience is far beneath the dignity of those who love God and neighbour. To strive for less than perfect love is to strive for too little." Father Thomas Rosica, CSB

FAITH EXPLORATION: Recently several people have enquired about the Catholic Faith. There are two elements to becoming a full member of the Catholic Church. One is internal – a growth in prayer and a personal relationship with God in faith – the other is more external at a level of learning about the Catholic Faith. Support for the former is needed at an individual level or perhaps several people sharing their experiences. Catechesis can be provided at a level which is open to all who want to find out more including cradle Catholics and especially parents who would like to be able to help their children understand the Faith better but feel ill-equipped. The *Evangelium* course provides an opportunity for this with about twenty five structured sessions based on a DVD and participants' book. I propose to try this out with weekly sessions starting after Half Term, probably on Friday evenings, 8.00-9.30 p.m., but want to check with the enquirers first. Another possibility would be Sunday evenings but I suspect this would be less popular. Confirmation of details will follow.

CONFIRMATION: The Bishop will be coming to the parish on **29th May** for his last pastoral visit before retirement. A couple marrying this Summer have asked to be prepared for Confirmation. If there are any young people 14+ or other adults who somehow missed out on Confirmation who would like to join them please let me know as soon as possible.
