Eleventh Sunday of Year

Her many sins have been forgiven, or she would not have shown such great love.

11TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: St Luke was a doctor and so it is not surprising that when he recounts Our Lord's life and teaching he has a special interest in stories of God's mercy and healing. St Luke alone gives us the parable of the Prodigal Son. Today he tells us of the woman with a bad reputation who comes into the house where Jesus and the disciples have been invited for a meal. Her tears wash his feet. She dries them with her hair and anoints them. Our Lord tells the critical guests that this outpouring of love is a response to God's forgiveness, and then openly says to her, "Your sins are forgiven." We do not need to be perfect to be loved by God. His love washes over us. We need only to be open to receiving that love through sorrow for our failings and a desire to be healed. When we approach the lord in the sacrament of reconciliation the same thing happens to us. We come to acknowledge our sorrow and demonstrate it through a small act of love (the penance) and we hear Jesus say to us through the lips of the priest, "I absolve you from your sins."

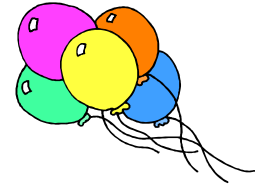
