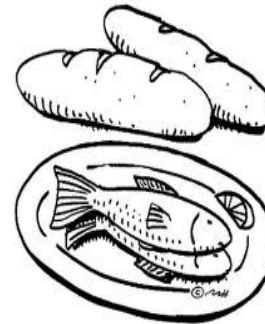

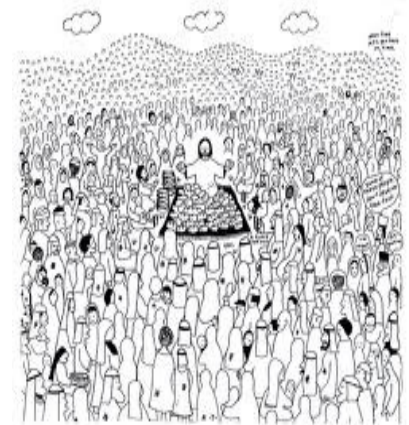

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY

18TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: Today is designated a 'Day for Life' – a day each year dedicated to celebrating the dignity of life from conception to natural death. This year the focus is on what it means to live a full and happy life. It takes as a starting point words spoken by Pope Benedict when he came to our country last year: "Happiness is something we all want, but one of the great tragedies in this world is that so many people never find it, because they look for it in the wrong places. The key to it is very simple – true happiness is to be found in God. We need to have the courage to place our deepest hopes in God alone, not in money, in a career, in worldly success, or in our relationships with others, but in God. Only he can satisfy the deepest needs of our hearts." The collection in the special envelopes today goes to the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other life-related projects supported by the Church.

SUMMER BREAK: During August there will be no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesday evenings or Saturday mornings. This will resume in September. 'RIDE & STRIDE': This annual event takes place on **Saturday 10th September**. People are invited to ride (bike or horse) or walk visiting a number of churches in their area. Half the proceeds goes to Friends of Essex Churches, who make grants to churches in need of support, and half is passed directly to the church nominated by the person doing the ride or walk. PAN-AFRICAN ANNUAL MASS: Will held on **Sunday 18th September** at 3.00 p.m. at St George's Catholic Church, 132 Shernhall Street, Walthamstow, London E17 9HU. The principal celebrant will be **Bishop Paul Hendricks** (Auxiliary Bishop of Southwark Archdiocese). In attendance will be the various African Choirs from **Congo, Ghana, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Ivory Coast** and **Nigeria**. All are cordially invited to join the African Communities to celebrate the Pan African Annual Mass. Afterwards there will be a Reception in the Parish Hall.

NEW ORGAN AT KELVEDON: A friend of Philip Prior, organist at St Peter's Church, Coggeshall, is disposing of an organ he has at home and is giving it to us for Kelvedon for a small donation. It is much newer and better in quality than our existing organ. The existing one will not go to waste. The removal firm will take it to Tiptree where it will continue to provide good service for a number of years. It has one or two recurrent faults and is nearing the end of its life but will offer more than the present small organ on occasions such as funerals. Throughout we have been advised by Andrew Wright –the Diocesan master of Music who thinks it a great acquisition. Such an instrument would cost £20k new and even second hand £4-6k. Our thanks go to Richard Tettmar, Philip Prior and all who have been involved in this process.
