If only you had faith!

27TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: God's gift brings with it a responsibility. This is true of every gift but especially that of the Holy Spirit. We are to be bold witnesses to the faith that has been entrusted to us. For us as Christians the truth can never simply be a matter of subjective opinion, as though something could be true for one person but not for another. It is objective reality revealed to us by God either through natural means or by the Holy Spirit when God reveals truths about himself. This is why St Paul tells Timothy to preserve carefully the pattern of sound teaching he has received as a precious gift. This is why the truths of Faith can be unfolded and explained but not changed, whereas purely human disciplinary matters can and often do change.

ADMISSIONS – PRIEST'S REFERENCE FORM: If you wish to apply for a place in a Catholic school for September 2011, you need to obtain a copy of the above form which is being distributed through the Catholic schools. Alternatively you can find the form on the Diocesan Website under "schools". The Diocese offers the following advice:

1. You can download the Priests' Reference form directly. You need to fill in **one copy** of Part A and take it to the appropriate Priest (preferably the Parish Priest of the Church where you regularly attend Mass).
2. With this Part A you need to have **as many copies of part B as the number of schools to which you are applying. You need to write the name of the school to which you are applying on the back of each Part B. For example, if you are applying to 3 Catholic schools, you need to give 3 copies of part B to the Priest. You must write on the back of each copy of Part B the name of one of the schools. The Priest will then send the Part B copies to the relevant schools.**
3. You should also give to the Priest a list of all the Catholic schools to which you are applying.
